(6.5 billion euros production value)





CEIR ORGANIZATION

GENERAL ASSEMBLY

The General Assembly consists of all members of CEIR. It is to be held once a year, presided over by the CEIR President or the Vice-President.



BOARD

CEIR is administered and controlled by a Board, which has to implement all decisions taken by the General Assembly and to deal with all matters of urgency occurring throughout the year. The Board controls the management of the Association's budget and finances.

COMMITTEES

Within CEIR there are 3 committees following marketing and technical matters.

Committee Members meet regularly in order to stay up-to-date and share information. They can participate in meetings with the European Commission and the EC-Joint Research Center. They are asked for their views on legislative proposals within Technical Committees.

They are also informed by the Committee secretariats and General Secretariat on legislative developments.


